### Theme for the term: Celebrating the Trinity

The content for the next two terms will focus on celebrating the central ideas of Christian belief through the Trinity of God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit

**The Trinity** is the belief that God is three separate persons but is still a single God. It is a complex and mysterious concept so to help everyone gain a deeper understanding of its relevance and importance we will focus upon looking at:

Jesus' life and some of the ways in which he is described (term 1)

The fruit of the Spirit – especially love – which ties in with Pentecost (term 1)

The Lord's Prayer (term 2)

This week we started to look at some stories about God the Son – Jesus as a boy, as a friend, as a teacher, as a helper:

Luke 2V 41-52

Matthew 4V18-22

Mark 10 V 17 - 25

We have also begun to look at, and share, the Lord's Prayer in readiness to explore it's meaning in term 2. A copy of the prayer is attached to the newsletter so you can share it together at home.
